



Tay Rowing Club Racking and Access Policy

Approved by Tay RC Committee at its meeting on October 20th 2016

Allocation of boat racking is a committee decision. Club members wishing to rack a private boat should fill in an application form and submit it to the Club President via email. Applicants will be notified in writing of the Committee's decision. If applicants are purchasing a new boat and are dependant on the club to rack it then please apply prior to purchase as any application for racking will be subject to appropriate availability.

RACKING FEES

The following fees will apply subject to annual review by the Club Committee. All figures are per seat

Private Boat – Exclusive Use only - £100 Owner fully responsible for insurance.

Private Boat – Club Use with permission - £50. Owner Insures. Minor damage to be paid for by the user when damage incurred.

Private Boat – general Club Use – Free. Club contribution to be agreed towards insurance prior to club use commencing. This will be no less than 50%. Minor damage paid for by club or whoever incurs the damage

Prices apply within a container/boatshed. Rates at 50% for outside storage in a secure compound

OUTINGS

It is recommended that people should not boat with no one else present.

Only private boat owners using their own boats can boat outside club hours. Club members using private boats can only boat during club sessions.

ACCESS

All adult approved owners of private boats will be allocated a key to access the relevant area.

Junior rowers will not be granted individual access.

A key deposit of £20 will be required. Returnable when member leaves the club or no longer requires racking.
